#### **CORBITT'S COMMENTS**

Dear Friends.

July is the month of Independence Day, when we celebrate our nation's founding and express our love for her. It is a good thing to love the place where we were born and raised, or the place that adopted us when we were strangers in a strange land.

Yes, we can love a place despite its imperfections, and despite our political and social unrest, and despite the questionable morality of some of our leaders, our nation is worth loving and defending, if for no other reason than the 1st Amendment to the US Constitution, which says,

"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."

We have grown so accustomed to our government recognizing these God-given liberties, that we have forgotten how earth-shattering this provision was when it was adopted 1789. No nation in the world at that time recognized the right to individual conscience, and even today some nations will persecute and prosecute people who express religious convictions deemed unacceptable to the society there. Thankfully, such travesties should never happen here because of the 1st Amendment.

Enjoying our liberty is not enough, however. We need to use it for God's glory. In World War II, the US became the "Arsenal of Democracy." In the 21st Century, may she become the "Springboard for Faith in Christ!" She will only be so, however, if we in the church leverage our liberty by practicing and promoting our faith. Are we up to the challenge?
